One result of decisions made at and subsequent to the 2006, Triennial Convention of the PSAC is the creation of the position of Regional Representative, Health and Safety for the Prairies. I am pleased to announce that I now hold this position.

I come to this position with a wide range of Union Health and Safety experience. I began as the Union Co-chair on my workplace committee. I expanded my knowledge and experience greatly as a Health and Safety facilitator in the Joint program at the Canada Customs and Revenue Agency. I completed all available levels of training through the Manitoba Federation of Labour in the Workers Compensation advocacy program. I was also the PSAC representative to the MFL H&S Committee as well as co-chair of that committee. While RVP I was also on UTE's National H&S Committee.

I have worked as a Regional Representative for the PSAC since July of 2003. I have specialized in all aspects of this job that relate to Health and Safety.

This is a new position in the Prairies; as such, many aspects of the work will be developed and defined over the upcoming year and in fact years to follow.
