FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT PRAIRIE REGION COUNCIL December 2 – 4, 2021

The PRC Finance Committee was ratified on September 12 2021 at the PRC meetings. Krysty Thomas was elected chair and Jennifer Chieh Ho was elected vice-chair. The committee met once over zoom for finance orientation on November 23rd. At that meeting the REVP explained how the finances of the region are reported and what spending authority the PRC has. The REVP also explained the 2021-2023 budget that was passed in June 2021 at the 8th Prairie Region Convention. It was noted that, due to COVID, a large amount of our allocated funds have not been spent at this time. It was discussed that at our next PRC meetings to be held December 2nd to 4th we should brainstorm ideas as a council on way to purposely spend these funds to serve and engage our membership. Quarterly statements for 2021 were not ready to review for the November 23rd meeting. The finance committee will meet again prior to the December 2-4th PRC meetings to review these statements and make recommendation to the PRC Council at that time. Finally, the finance committee is to review the terms of reference for adoption at the February meetings of the PRC.
