## CONVENTION 2026 BULLETIN #5, JUNE, 2026

The 10th Triennial Prairie Region Convention will be held in Calgary, AB June 5-7, 2026 at the BMO Centre Stampede Park. This bulletin provides important information for delegates and observers.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Delegates are reminded to bring their delegate credentials with them to the BMO Centre. Credentials must be worn at all times while on the convention floor, and access will not be permitted without them.

### CONVENTION MATERIALS

If you are considering putting your name forward for a Prairie Regional Council position, please note all relevant information is also available on the convention website.

We want to ensure you have the best possible convention experience, so we would like to highlight a few important items to help make your time enjoyable. Please bring the following:

#### Convention backpack

Exciting news! Delegates, guests and observers will receive a PSAC Prairies backpack as convention swag this year instead of a tote bag.

#### Water bottle

We will not be supplying water bottles. Please bring one with you. Water bottle filling stations will be available throughout the convention centre, and a map of their locations will be provided.

#### Portable phone/laptop charger

Charging stations will be available in plenary spaces, however, there are a limited amount and they require you to leave your seat. We highly recommend you bring a portable charger so you can stay seated and fully charged.

#### Red PSAC shirts/Political Action

During the lunch break on June 5, we will be holding a political action and have changed the location to on site, but still outside. Delegates are encouraged to bring and wear red PSAC Union Pride, Prairie Wide, or PSAC in Our Community shirts if available. More details about the action will be shared during convention. On June 6, delegates are encouraged to wear a blue jean jacket in honour of Missing, Murdered, and Exploited Indigenous Men and Boys.

## EVENT CODE PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

*Parking at Calgary Stampede Park is managed and enforced by Calgary Parking through the ParkPlus system.*

This unique code must be entered **DAILY** into a ParkPlus pay machine to ensure your licence plate is registered. Event codes cannot be entered on the ParkPlus app or website.

### **Additional Information**

- Parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- The event code option is only available at the pay machines. The code cannot be used on the ParkPlus MyParking app.
- No refunds will be offered for customers who pay for their parking instead of using the event code.

***Failure to register the event code and licence plate at the ParkPlus pay machine may result in a parking infraction.***

### **How to Use Your Event Code for Parking at Calgary Stampede**

1. Park your vehicle and note your licence plate number. We recommend taking a photo of your licence plate to have the information handy.
2. Proceed to the ParkPlus pay machine. At the pay machine, follow these steps to enter the event code and your licence plate number:
  - a. Press the Event Code button located at the bottom of the screen.
  - b. Enter the event code provided above and press the green checkmark on the screen when completed.
  - c. Enter your licence plate number and press the green checkmark.
  - d. Press whether you would like a receipt. You don't need to return to your vehicle or display a receipt on the dash.
