## 6. Treasurer's Report/Financial Statement

We have submitted our annual financial documents for 2025 to the REVP office for approval and are waiting to hear if the PAAC met all the requirements to be considered in good standing.

## 8. New Business – Guest Speaker Kari Lentowicz

Kari shared her experience living through the Denare Beach Wildfires.

- 90 homes, 240 homes destroyed by fire – many residents displaced which could have been avoided if the government had sent help when the community requested assistance.
- Kari shared her wants and needs from our PAAC – lobbying government specifically Saskatchewan Government Insurance (SGI) and increased Mental Health Supports.
- Kari has prepared a document with all the specifics on what is needed to rebuild the community and will share it with us.

- Tracy shared that her local has been very busy.
- Dalton shared that the local is busy. Micromanagement is occurring and quotas for e-services/e-SIN's used to be by region and now it is by office.

- Trina/Dawn/Marissa - employer is doing a complete reorganization, vacant positions are not being staffed and causing stress to the membership.
