12) Bargaining updates

- FB bargaining started in Feb 2026. Met in June to finalize demands. End of June exchange demands with employer. FB group was first table to get seniority put into the CA. Employer is trying to eliminate seniority it from CA. Only table that this demand has come up.
- Wear black third Wednesday of every month. Member mobilization is a priority.
- Casino Regina is back at bargaining September 23-24
- TC will enter mediation September 15-17, will bypass PIC
- PA mediation September 29-30, will bypass PIC
- EB mediation Oct 8-9, will bypass PIC
- SV September 14-17 bargaining. Binding arbitration route
- Parks 9-10 September bargaining. Employer has begun rolling out WFA. Will have a day of action early September
- CRA: FPSLRE Board approved this bargaining unit to bypass the PIC process in July. Townhalls will begin for these members in September
- CFIA September 22-23 bargaining
- September 9 in Regina PSAC Summit for TB Local executives.

- CUPE going into a strike vote very soon
- Eric has 'Remote Works' swag to share. Toques, magnets, and mousepads. Will bring some to the Labour Day Picnic

- Dee shared UNIFOR 594 – Co-op Refinery has requested to the City to set up a 500 bed scab camp. Lockout gearing up. SK has no strike breaker laws
